Secure, single point of entry system for access control, electrified fencing, surveillance cameras and separate security companies manning the gate and DC facilities.

Conveniently located near two major airports. Walvis Bay International Airport is only 50 km away and can be reached in less than an hour by car. Windhoek Hosea Kutako International Airport is 400 km away and requires a drive of about four and a half hours.
